June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017

Dearest Parish Family,

This week has brought much news for our little parish! On Friday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, we received word that Rev. Mr. William (Bill) Shaw has been officially appointed by our Bishop, the Most Rev. Fr. Peter Jugis, to assist at the parish. I believe this might be the first deacon that has been assigned in the parish so this is a moment of great joy. In addition to his responsibilities here, Deacon Shaw is an Advocate (one who assists with marriage investigations) and an Assessor (one who advises the judge) for the Marriage Tribunal in the Diocese of Charlotte. He also brings a wealth of knowledge from both his secular careers (Police Officer, Director of Airfield Maintenance & Operations at PTI Airport in Greensboro) and his ministry (ordained over 38 years). Additionally, he served in the Armed Forces (Navy & Air Force). He and his wife, my mother, Ann, have been married almost 51 years, have 9 children, and 16 grandchildren. We are blessed to have him in the parish and hope that he will be able to minister for many years yet to come.

He is currently the Campus Minister for the colleges & universities in the Charlotte area, including UNC-Charlotte. Fr. Innocent recently earned his doctorate from Fordham University.
