Dear Parish Family,

Have you ever wondered why after the Easter season and the great Feast of the Church of Pentecost, that we immediately turn to celebrating several other Solemnities in the following weeks? Doesn't it seem like maybe we should space these out so that they last over the entirety of the weeks that bridge Pentecost to Advent? While that would be nice, I think that the Church's mind is that we *need* these celebrations to help us to focus on accomplishing the task before us during these weeks.

In its own way, we have been given a representation of the basis of our Faith: After receiving the Holy Spirit (Pentecost Sunday), we are able to know the highest mystery of who God is (Trinity Sunday) and recall the depth of His love for us (Corpus Christi Sunday). With all of that in our minds and hearts, now we have all that is necessary to be the disciples that Christ sends out into the world, proclaiming the *Evangelium* (the Good News, the Gospel). In response to our choice to be His disciples, living as He has taught us and seeking the Kingdom of Heaven for ourselves and others, He asks us to go out into the vineyard of the all the world, to cultivate and harvest the souls that He planted the seed of Faith into when He created them.

How can we do this? Through the model we have: First, spend time deepening your relationship with God in prayer. Then enter into the mystery of our Lord's Passion & Resurrection, through receiving the Most Blessed Sacrament or allowing ourselves to hunger for it if we cannot receive Him. Finally, go out and use the knowledge, love, and graces to be faithful to what God asks you to do for that day. In this way, we are able to be His disciples, preparing the world for Him!
