Dear Parish Family,

In 1859, the Church found Herself in a time of transition while in was in the midst of losing some of its temporal power when it loss the "Papal States". Pope Pius IX, fully away of it being a moment of change in the life of the Church Militant, the Church here on earth, called for prayers to be offered after the end of Mass that the Church might be protected from those who sought to destroy Her.

In 1884, 1904, & again in 1929, the Church reaffirmed the need for these prayers to be said for the protection of the Church. Some might recall that our bishops here in the United States called for the praying for the protection of the liberty of the Church through the recitation of the

"Prayer to St. Michael". In these days, it seems eminently important to being praying for the protection of the Church, not from some outside, secular force seeking to seize landholding, but from the most ancient foe of the Church, the devil who is always seeking to destroy and distract, and from men whose hearts have lost focus on the love of God & the Sacrifice of Christ. This is why I have recently called for the praying of the "Prayer to St. Michael, the Archangel" at the end of Masses. We have been offering these prayers after daily Masses for a few years now, but now it is important that we extend these prayers to each day. The struggle in the life of the Church is intense right now, and our prayers should rise in intensity to match that need. Let us call upon our great protectors of the Church, St. Michael & St. Joseph, to aid us through their intercession before God Almighty!
