Dear Parish Family,

Still building off of last week's bulletin, each of us are called to bring the Gospel message into the world: to our family, to our friends & coworkers, to any stranger who comes across our path. So, should we all be preaching & teaching? Should we all be working in soup kitchens, hospitals, & orphanages? These, and many others, are good and noble activities that build the Faith. Yet, not all have talents or skills that let them do all of these well. Part of our responsibility in living the Faith well is examining where our strengths (skills, interests, virtues) are and where God is calling us to use them for His glorification and our sanctification. Two terms that have been somewhat lost over the last several decades are Charisms & Apostolates. We believe that God has given us particular strengths in this life, which are called "Charisms". We can build up these strengths (through the Holy Spirit), as we continue to seek the repentance & graces (through the Son), so that we can fulfill the mission entrusted to us (by the Father). The people & place to which we

are sent is called an "Apostolate". The word "Apostle" means "one who is sent/messenger/envoy". In summary, each of us, in union with the Most Blessed Trinity, are entrusted with a specific portion of the mission Christ gave to the Church: the salvation of souls. Our charisms, given to us by God, are tailored to aid us in the mission and we are sent intentionally placed among people and in a place that is where we are to use those charisms, our apostolate. As one family in the Faith, we receive from Christ the tools that are necessary to live the life He offers us through the Sacraments & knowledge of the Faith. Then, we are sent throughout this parish, to the many people & places, so that all might have an opportunity to hear the Gospel. To truly be a Christian is a full-time identity.
