Dear Parish Family,

First, I want to offer a word of gratitude for the prayers that were offered for all those who attended the Eucharistic Congress that was held in Charlotte last weekend. It was a beautiful day of prayer & growing in understanding about the richness of the Faith. Thousands upon thousands were gathered together for the procession with the Most Blessed Sacrament through the streets of downtown Charlotte, for the talks offered throughout the day, for adoration of Our Blessed Lord, to go to confession, and for the closing Mass at the end of Saturday. It truly was a glorious and blessed day. I hope that next year we can have a few more parishioners attend. In addition to myself & Deacon Shaw, two parishioners from St. Joseph's and several from Our Lady of Guadalupe

Mission attended this year.

This Saturday (September 15th) also saw the ground breaking for phase one of the buildings that are being constructed here in the Diocese of Charlotte for St. Joseph College Seminary near the campus of Belmont Abbey College. This phase of construction will build 40 seminarian rooms, a refectory and a kitchen, a conference room, classrooms, administrative offices, a research room, exercise room, faculty rooms, guest rooms, a cloister walk, and a temporary chapel. Currently, we are blessed to already have 22 college age men in temporary housing and expect that number will grow next year to around 30. The seminary is still fund raising for this project, which is projected to cost around \$20 million for phase one. Right now, they are in the "major gifts" phase of fund-raising and will move to a general fund-raising phase next year throughout the diocese. Please keep St. Joseph College Seminary in your prayers as the move forward with preparing the next generation of priests for service in our diocese!
