Dear Parish Family,

This weekend, we are taking up the annual "Priest Retirement & Benefits Collection" throughout the Diocese. By way of explanation, in the mid-1990's our late Bishop Curlin saw that the retired priests from our diocese were struggling to have basic living and health expenses covered. This was because no adjustments had been made to the benefits in over 20 years, from the early 1970's until his time as Bishop. In order to make sure that no other retired priests would need to choose between food or heat or medication, he ordered that the retirement benefits be increased to a more reasonable level. To accomplish this, it was decided that a collection would be taken up each year to augment the funds available for this necessity. As many of you have likely noticed, there have been a great number of priests who have retired over the past few years, so we continue to give back to these men who have given their lives and talents to help each of us, as they best knew how, to grow closer to Christ. This is a separate collection from the DSA and we at

St. Joseph's & Our Lady of Guadalupe are asked to raise \$2,578 & \$990, respectively. 81% of this will go to helping Diocesan priests who have served in our Diocese, 14% will go to religious orders who have staffed parishes in our diocese, and 5% goes to cover administrative cost. Whatever we are unable to raise through your generosity will be assessed as a tax on our parish and will need to be paid from operating or parish savings accounts.
