### Sunday of the 30<sup>th</sup> Week in Ordinary Time

October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017

Dear Parish Family,

Over the course of the past few weeks, I have been receiving input from anyone who was willing to express an opinion about the time for daily Masses. Some expressed a desire to see the daily Mass time be one that is accessible for people who work, while others reinforced the idea that it should be at an hour that is also mindful for those who are either retired or vacationing, who would likely not want to wake up too early. Both are valuable and valid points. In an attempt to heed the advice offered to me, I would like to do a trial run during the month of November of having daily Mass at 12 Noon on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, & Fridays and having Wednesday evening Masses at 6pm. This change will be posted at both St. Joseph's & OLG, on our parish website, as well as on the parish Facebook page. Again, this is simply a trial run. If it is successful in bringing more people to Mass on a regular basis, it may become permanent. It will be completely dependent on whether people show up on a regular basis. In other news, at the request of some parishioners at OLG Mission, we will begin to have Exposition & Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament on Friday evenings at 8:00pm in OLG. This will be in addition to the regularly scheduled Adoration time on Fridays after Mass at St. Joseph's. I hope to begin on December 8<sup>th</sup>, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which is also the first Friday in Advent. There are a few items that need to be purchased before we begin to have Adoration at OLG, which is why there is a delay. Please keep an eye out for more about both of these issues going forward. Finally, this Wednesday is a Holy Day of Obligation, the Solemnity of All Saints. Mass times will be held at the usual Holy Day times – 12:10 at OLG and 6pm at St. Joseph's. The Commemoration of the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day) will be on Thursday. There will be a 12 Noon Mass at St. Joseph's with the blessing of the graves (located at the Crucifix in front of St. Joseph's) following Mass. I hope many will attend this beautiful & special Masses.
