Also, these prayers can gain a plenary indulgence "each day of the year," but "no more than once a day": Eucharistic Adoration (lasting at least a half hour), the Rosary (in a church or oratory, or as a family, in a religious community, and in general when several of the faithful gather for some honest purpose), Reading or listening to Sacred Scriptures (from a text approved by a competent authority, and with the reverence due to the divine word, for at least a half an hour; if the time is less, the indulgence will be partial), and Stations of the Cross (prayed in a church or where legitimately erected). Also, there's the St. Gertrude Prayer specifically to release souls from purgatory: "Eternal Father I offer you the most precious blood of your divine son Jesus, in union with all the Masses said throughout the world today, for all the holy souls in purgatory, for sinners everywhere, sinners in the Universal Church, those in my own home and within my family. Amen." ~ Fr. Shaw
