Dear Parish Family,

Continuing to bring attention to devotions and opportunities to increase our piety to our patron, St. Joseph, during this year in our Diocese dedicated to him, I would like to point some devotions that are both powerful & beautiful. For this week, I would like to focus on a new 33 day consecration to St. Joseph.

While notions of a personal consecration to Our Lord through His Mother can be found as early as the 4th & 5th centuries, the idea of a consecration to Our Lord through St. Joseph seems to be more recently developed. I don't think it a "coincidence" that as we are dedicating special attention to St. Joseph this year that a new 33-day consecration to Our Lord through St. Joseph has been published. With that in mind, I would like to get a group together for our parish to do this consecration so that it ends on March 19th, the Solemnity of St. Joseph. We would need to start the consecration on February 16th, so we will need to order

the book "**Consecration to St. Joseph**" by Fr. Donald Calloway, MIC soon. Anyone who wants to participate but cannot afford the book can speak to me. Our first group meeting will be held on February 16th after the 11:15am Sunday Mass. I pray that many of you consider this act of spiritual gratitude and commitment to our parish patron!
