It is with a heavy heart that I announce to the parish the passing away of Angie DiLillo & Louis Gantnier. Angie is the daughter of Connie DiLillo and the sister of Kathy Posey, both of whom are deeply involved in our parish and are generous in helping whenever anything needs doing. Angie's passing came quicker than anticipated, but it means the end of her struggle with stage 4 cancer which she had been battling for the past several months. The arrangements for her funeral will be as follows:

- Vigil at Crisp Funeral Home on Sunday, May 19th, at 5 pm.
- Funeral Mass on Monday, May 20th, at 10 am followed by burial at Swain Memorial Park immediately after the Mass.

Louis Gantnier had been a regular parishioner here at St. Joseph's and at Our Lady of Guadalupe. He fell ill several months ago and was not able to make it to Mass since then. Arrangements are still being made at this time.
